

URETHANE MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

SmithMade's Urethane Finishes are quick and easy to maintain. You will need a microfiber cleaning pad and SmithMade's premium Urethane cleaner for weekly cleaning. SmithMade's premium urethane cleaner removes dirt and grease, while drying fast leaving no residue behind. For weekly cleaning start by thoroughly dusting and sweeping the surface. SmithMade premium Urethane cleaner can be evenly sprayed onto the surface, then with a clean microfiber pad gently scrub the floor. Repeat in areas with excess grease or dirt, especially in high traffic areas. A damp cleaning is sufficient. Allow to dry for 10 minutes before continuing regular use.

For monthly maintenance, a thorough cleaning is necessary to assure longevity of your finish. You will need a premium microfiber mop and two buckets. The first bucket will be filled with clean water, the second bucket will be filled with warm water along with 1 teaspoon of mild dish soap. The mild dish soap will remove tough grease and dirt. Clean the surface with a Premium Microfiber Mop, rinsing with clean water between cleaning. It is important that edges and corners are cleaned to insure sheen uniformity. Be certain not to use excessive water or leave behind puddles. EXCESS WATER WILL DAMAGE THE FLOORING. A damp cleaning is sufficient. Allow to dry for 10 minutes before continuing regular use.

Contact your local refinisher for bi-yearly maintenance. Recoating SmithMade urethane finish needs to be performed by a professional.
